Themes

Both qualitative and quantitative contributions are welcome.

We invite articles with a sociological or interdisciplinary focus which address at least one of the following themes;

- The role of and challenges facing community groups or services in supporting (adult and child) victims of domestic violence, human trafficking or forced marriage

- Violence between children and young people and policy or practice responses
- Human trafficking and its policy and practice consequences
- Forced Marriage and its policy and practice implications
- Service user involvement in the design development and evolution of services responding to domestic violence and related issues
- Access to and pathways through support services for users (and potential users) of services

Priority will be given to those articles that contain original data and/or present new theoretical insights that will have relevance to a wide audience of readers.

Deadline

The deadline for initial receipt of manuscripts is April 30, 2011. The final notification of acceptance will be made by July 1st, 2011.
